Motor Oil in Italy

There are 3 tax-free ways to buy motor oil in Vicenza

- Coupons from the PX (like gas coupons)
- AAFES Car Care Center (must be used on the premises)
- Auto Skill Shop (must be used on the premises)

Coupons:

	Coupons	At AGIP
AGIP Non-synthetic "Super" Oil.	\$10.80 per liter	\$17.33 (13 Euro)
AGIP Synthetic	\$12.30 per liter	\$18.66 (14 Euro)

AAFES Car Care center for \$7.99/quart for Synthetic.

Auto Skills: Mobil 1 \$7.50/quart, Castrol GTX \$4.90/quart

Naples NEX - stocks synthetic for \$20 per liter

Signonella NEX - stocks IP non-synthetic oil for \$9.49. It is cheaper because it is low quality, the market is softer and they may be choosing to take a loss.

If Vicenza stocked oil it would cost more than the AAFES no-coupon rate.

Propane in the VMC



PROPANE – The Auto Skills Center offers propane tank refills for Gas Grills.

1. We are improving the service by almost doubling the number of tanks available.
2. Tanks are filled on Tuesdays and Fridays at ~ 1500 hours.
3. We believe this will solve the problem and if it does not we will buy more tanks.
4. A “Blue Rhino” type operation at the PX = ugly, less safe, costs more and takes staff out of the store. I doubt we will do that.
5. We think the inconvenience of having to go to the Auto Skills Center 2-3 times a year to fill your propane tank is acceptable.
6. Purchase a charged tank from Tue-Fri 1200-2000 or Sat from 0900-1700 - charge includes appropriate taxes. DSN: (314) 634-7014 for more info.
