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Energy Conservation

- October is Energy Awareness Month
- Utility bills are the largest single budgetary item for USAG-Vicenza besides labor at \$17M/yr
- Garrison has invested heavily in initiatives to reduce those energy costs:
 - CoGen Ederle \$6M ESPC
 - PV at Ederle/Villaggio/Del Din/Livorno Depot \$10+M
 - HVAC Retrofits \$2+M
 - LED Street Lighting \$850K
- However we need your help, the best/easiest way to reduce energy costs is to use it wisely
- Heating Season officially starts on 15 October and lasts through 15 April
 - Please be patient as the switch-over from cooling to heating takes time as there are over 120 separate systems that need to be switched
 - Priority is for Youth Facilities, Schools, Barracks, Community Facilities, etc.
 - 20-22C is the max temperature so please assist with not exceeding the max and help save energy costs

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Influenza Vaccine

1. Plenty of Vaccine...FluMist and FluZone
2. Vaccine type is based on screening criteria and not on personal preference
3. Recommended for all beneficiaries
4. High Risk Groups:
 - A. Children
 - B. Pregnant Women
 - C. Age >50
 - D. Chronic Medical Conditions

Children

1. Must have Pediatric and Adolescent Influenza Screening Questionnaire completed and signed by a parent
2. DoDDS Immunization Clinics:
 - A. 15 OCT 0830-1100 Elementary School
 - B. 16 OCT 0830-1100 Elementary School
 - C. 16 OCT 1230-1500 Middle School
 - D. 17 OCT 1230-1530 High School

Special Events

1. Retiree Appreciation Day 18 OCT
2. CYSS Employee Vaccinations mid-OCT

All Beneficiaries Beginning 14 OCT

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Cats

1. Stray cats protected by Italian Law
2. Significant population at Villaggio
3. Recent increased incidence of cat bites
4. Cats bite when people try to pet or handle them

Concerns

1. Potential for Rabies exposure
2. 95% of cat bites become infected...seek medical attention



Mitigation

1. Don't feed or handle stray cats
2. Vet Clinic live trap/spay/neuter program
