In **NOV 2013**, Italian EOD discovered a 4,000lb British WWII era bomb Approx 200m adjacent to **Caserma Del Din**.

Prefettura ordered that all residents within a **2.5-kilometer radius** of the bomb to evacuate by **7:30 a.m., April 25**.

USAG-V EOC reports to the *Prefettura* that all Del Din residents and Employees have been evacuated. The **UXO removal will begin at 9:00 a.m., April 25**.



AR 385-10 - Bicycle helmets, approved by the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)

Bicycles will be equipped with operable headlights and taillights

Clothing recommended during daylight

Bicycling on roadways on DOD installations during hours of darkness or reduced visibility

Bicyclist will wear a reflective upper outer garment

High visibility reflective clothing (PT Belt, Vest) will be worn at night

Bicycles maintained IAW Italian Law (Codice Della Strada)



Top 10 Things Sponsor Should Inform Newcomer of Prior to Arrival

- **1. Visit website Visit Plan My Move website-- Consult this website in preparation of your upcoming move. <http://www.militaryinstallations.dod.mil> and contact Relocation Readiness Relocation Readiness at: relocation@vicenza.mwr.com for any questions regarding moving to Vicenza.**
- **2. Command Visa/Command Sponsorship/Passport/Visa-- Make sure newcomers spouse/family has command sponsorship and official passport and visa before arriving in Italy.**
- **3. Stateside License Stateside & International Drivers License— Make sure all drivers have valid drivers licenses. It is recommended that all drivers obtain an International drivers license from AAA. Inform them to avoid bringing those large SUV's.**
- **4. Prepare for smaller housing--Homes in Italy can be much smaller then stateside homes and there is less storage space available, so plan accordingly.**
- **5. Hotel! — Tell them to make hotel reservations as soon as they have their date of arrival. The Ederle Inn fills up quickly. DSN: 634-8034 or 8035 Commercial line: 039-0444-71-8034 or 8035.**

Top 10 Things Sponsor Should Inform Newcomer of Prior to Arrival *Continued...*

- **6. Set up CMR Box --It is highly recommended that newcomer obtain a postal box so they can have their mail forwarded. They can do so via online at : <http://www.usag.vicenza.army.mil/sites/local/postal.asp>**
- **7. They cannot operate a home business here in Italy (Pampered Chef, Amway etc.)**
- **8. Health Records--If leaving from a military installation, export CYS paperwork for dependent children including valid immunization forms. Tell them to hand carry immunization records/important medical records. Do not ship these items.**
- **9. Pets—If bringing pets, make sure they go to the “Shipping Pets” tab on the plan my move website.**
- **10. Large appliances--Do not bring large appliances such as: washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers or refrigerators. These appliances may not fit in their home and the set-up is different as is the voltage. Italy uses 220v not 110v as in the States. The housing office will loan these items during their duration here.**

Space-A Care

- USAHC-V Mission is to take care of our Soldiers and their Families
- Must provide access to care for TRICARE beneficiaries above all other missions
- DoD, MEDCOM, ERMC, and LRMC regulations and policy
- Priority of Care:
 - Priority 1: Active Duty (AD)
 - Priority 2: AD Family Members (ADFM) in TRICARE Prime
 - Priority 3: Retirees + FM in TRICARE Plus
 - Priority 4: ADFM not Prime
 - Priority 5: Retirees + FM not Plus
 - Priority 6: Space-A
- MTF Commanders may authorize but not guarantee Space-A care
- It is my intent to guarantee care for our TRICARE beneficiaries while maximizing the healthcare provided to our VMC

What has not changed?

- USAHC-V will see non-TRICARE civilians on a Space-A basis for acute healthcare issues
- Our Patient Liaisons will assist non-TRICARE civilians on a Space-A basis at San Bortolo
- USAHC-V Pharmacy will accept Italian prescriptions that satisfy documentation requirements for ERMIC formulary medications
- All civilian employees must carry third party insurance to address their medical needs OCONUS
- USAHC-V will ensure that internal processes support the maximal amount of daily healthcare for our entire community

What has changed?

- Space-A patients may call at 1100 Mon-Wed and Fri for acute appointments
- Space-A patients will not be seen for chronic medical issues
- USAHC-V staff will not take telephone consults for Space-A patients for issues not related to a previous acute issue
- USAHC-V providers will not translate Italian prescriptions into our pharmacy
- Patient Liaisons will not translate medical records or attend Italian network outpatient appointments for Space-A patients
- Referral Management will not make appointments for Space-A patients on the Italian network

The Way Forward

- We recommend all Retirees and their Family Members enroll in TRICARE Plus
- We are currently working a communication and transition plan to the network for Space-A patients that have received chronic care

 - “Transition” visits
- English-speaking Italian Physician List

VICENZA ALLARGA IL CUORE (VICENZA'S WIDENING ITS HEART) SOME TIPS...

- Be advised that all around the ZTL several cameras are installed all around the perimeter and if you cross, not authorized, the restricted area, you'll be fined each time you pass by any camera. That would result in multiple tickets on the same day.
- Due to the fact that our vehicles hold cover plates that are nationally registered in Rome, it could take a few weeks to the Local Police before they identify the vehicle's owner. Therefore don't feel safe if don't receive the ticket the next day...
- In case of infractions that prescribe reduction of points from your driver license, you have to let the Local Police know who was driving the vehicle within 60 days from the notification of the ticket
- You may be entitled to 30% discount if you pay your ticket within 5 days from its notification, except the cases that prescribe your driving license be suspended.
