Drinking Water Sampling in High Risk Facilities

- ***VMC High Risk Facilities (HRF) to be sampled: Villaggio (Preschool Wing and CDC), Ederle CDCs (Bldgs. 308, 395, 398) and Ederle Youth Center (Bldg. 373). DMC HRFs to be sampled: Elementary School, CDC (Bldg. 726), Youth Center (Bldg. 730)***
- Upcoming sampling, part of U.S. Army's effort to ensure Soldiers, Civilians, and Family Members have access to safe drinking water.
Chemical of concern: Lead (can cause developmental issues in children)
- Original testing for Lead was conducted in 2013. **No issues identified.**
- Follow up testing (June 2016) to include same locations plus Bldg. 395 **CDC** (which was not in use in 2013)
- If lead above the action level is found in drinking water at these facilities, immediate notification will be given to parents of children in that facility and measures will be taken to ensure the highest level of protection for those children in the Army's care.





- Save your money - paying for 1- or 2-day express mail service(s) will not help you get your mail faster
- Do not put "ITALY" on any part of your address, this causes delays and may subject the recipient to custom (duty) fees
- Use your zip code + 4 to help us get mail into your box quicker
- Remove yourself from mailing lists for unwanted mail
- Sign up for e-bills and e-statements
- When you PCS, ensure the post office has a forwarding address for you

- Required 25 Directorates/Tenant Organizations
- Required HN Carabinieri, ILO, SUEM, EOD (Padova), GIS (Livorno)

7 R's of an Exercise or Real World Event

- RESPOND – LE/DES/Carabinieri/VHC/SUEM
 - RESTRICT – LE/DES/Carabinieri
 - RESOLVE – GIS
 - RECOVER – SUEM/ARC/DPW/RMO/All Tenants
 - REVIEW – AAR/All
 - RETRAIN – All/As needed

Independence Day Access Control



- Gate 1 (Main Gate) Registered guests of DOD ID Card Holders and LN Installation Pass Access with sign-in privileges must be requested NLT 241200Jun16 for access through Gate 1. Please fill out AE Form 190-16F (Access Roster). Email form immediately to usarmy.usag-Italy.usag.list.usag-vicenza-des-iacs@mail.mil with a subject line of INDEPENDENCE DAY 2016. For more information, please call DSN 314-634-7053.
- Gate 2 (Chapel Gate) normal gate operations from 1630-1830. The gate will also be open for outbound traffic from 2300-0030.
- Gate 5 Via Corbetta (Clinic Gate) will be open from 1600-0001 hrs for entry and exit of all guests. This will be the only access point for NON DOD ID Card Holders unless they are pre-registered escorted guests of an ID Card Holder.
- Only pre-registered guests will be allowed to sign-in into Caserma Ederle from 1600-0030; all others will be sent to gate 5 for access.
- The following items are prohibited: Backpacks, Bikes, Scooter, Skateboards, Hover Boards, Pets, Coolers, Bottles, Glass Containers, etc. The only exception is for infant care. i.e strollers,

DOD ID Card Access

- DOD ID Card holders are requested to enter the event from inside Caserma Ederle.
- The two internal access points for the event are located near the Arena and near Bldg 340 the Ederle Inn.
- DOD ID Card holders who sign in guests (up to 4) must exit at the two access points within Caserma Ederle and ensure they have their guests off post NLT 0030. Any guests that loses their pass will be required to exit at Gate 5.

Installation Pass Access

- Installation Pass Holders can enter the event at any location.
- Installation Pass Holders with sign in privileges can sign in guests, but must pre-register their guests at the PMO Pass and Badge Office prior to the event.
- Installation Pass Holders can exit at the two access points within Caserma Ederle or Gate 5, but must ensure they have their guests off post NLT 0030.
