Full Scale Exercise - May 10

- Mirrors Recent Attacks in Paris, Brussels, and 2008 in Mumbai simulated a coordinated attack at multiple locations
- Barrier Plan will be implemented – minimal impact to parking with the exception of Ederle Inn (no parking in front of the Inn)
- Post Wide Lock Down to include all tenants
- HN and U.S. combined effort to resolve
- Duration: 2 – 2 1/2 hours 9 a.m.-11:30 a.m.

Peak-Season

- Defense Personal Property System (DPS)
 - Upon receipt of your orders, contact local Transportation Office
 - Registration in DPS it is now required by logging onto www.move.mil, then click on *Before You Move*.
 - Ensure order information is correct
 - Pack and pickup dates NLT 35 days out
 - No leave forms are required
 - Military personnel weight entitlement (5,000 lbs to 18,000 lbs)
 - Civilians personnel 18,000 lbs
 - Unaccompanied Baggage (UB) Military 500 lbs to 2,000 lbs
 - UB MIL Dependant 350 lbs or 175 lbs
 - UB CIV & Dependant 350 lbs or 175lbs

- Shipping a motorcycle in HHG you need
 - Title and registration or Bill of Sale plus the registration
 - MOPED and motor scooters over 50cc require above documents

- Shipping Wine
 - Check the your destination state for permit requirements by logging onto <http://ttb.gov/wine/state-ABC.shtml>
 - Pickup a wine shipping packet at local Transportation (Ederle: bldg 393, 2nd floor)

Vehicle Registration Tips

- To clear you must SHIP/SELL/or SCRAP all your vehicles/motorcycles
- Bring all copies of HHG showing motorcycle in shipment
- To ship a car commercially you must have a copy of your shipping documents.
- To sell a vehicle: The seller must get a safety inspection within 30 days. The buyer should call vehicle registration at 637-7820 or 637-7822
- To junk a vehicle, come to vehicle registration to get the paperwork. Clearing will only be allowed after the vehicle is turned in.
- To ship, contact the Vehicle Processing Center, 634-7760
- PCSing within Europe, you must turn in your cover plates, and Temporary AFI plates will be issued to drive across Europe.



Vehicle Registration Tips (Cont.)

- Shipping a Vehicle Government: Make an appointment online at www.pcsmypov.com. For additional information contact 634-7760.
- On the day of your appointment the vehicle must be cleaned inside and out to include the trunk under the spare tire and the air filter. Any dirt will result in failure to pass.
- Vehicle must have less than $\frac{1}{4}$ tank of gas, anything over will fail.
- There can not be any fluid leaks.
- Only floor mats, baby seat, first aid kit, warning triangle can be shipped inside the vehicle.
- Italian cover plates must be returned or a lost license plate statement from the SETAF Carabinieri.

Information about PCSing with pets

Things to remember when it comes time to PCS with your pet(s):

- Your pet(s) will need a 15-digit microchip, a valid Rabies vaccination and a Pet Passport.
- Different countries have various requirements for incoming animals.
 - Please contact the veterinary clinic for those requirements.

Flying with your pet(s):

- Your pet(s) will need their Pet Passport signed by a veterinarian and a Health Certificate Exam [within 10 days of travel].
- Depending on the size/breed of your animal special crates and/or plans may need to be arranged.
 - Contact SATO and/or airlines for these specific arrangements.
