What is AFAP?

What is AFAP?

- The “Voice of the Customer”
- Engages Soldiers, Families, survivors, retirees, and Department of the Army Civilians to identify, prioritize, and elevate quality of life issues to senior leaders for action and resolution

What has AFAP done?

- Since 1983, 698 issues have entered AFAP
 - 528 issues resolved; 160 classified as unattainable
- Driving force behind the enactment of:
 - 129 pieces of legislation
 - 187 policy changes
 - 212 improved programs and services
- Currently working action plans for 10 active AFAP issues



What is a “Quality of Life” Issue?

Family Support (CYSS, ACS, Youth Sports, Child Care Services)

Soldier Support/Transportation (Relocation Services, Drivers License, Lending Closet, Finance, Educational Services)

Medical and Dental

Military Facilities (DFACS, Gyms, Libraries, Barracks, Housing)

Benefits and Entitlements (AER, TSP, GI Bill, Commissary, ESSO, Rations Card, Retirement Benefits)


What is not within the scope of AFAP?

Items outside Department of the Army Staff tasking authority to resolve:

- Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA), Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA)/Department of Defense Dependents Schools (DoDDS), or Army Emergency Relief (AER) issues
- Sister services or secretariat issues
- State’s rights issues
- Issues that can be resolved by your command.




Garrison Based AFAP Process

Winter Driving – be prepared

- **Prepare yourself**
 - Plenty of rest
 - 6-8 hours sleep
 - 30-40% drivers admit falling asleep at the wheel
 - 20hrs awake = .05 BAC
- **Discipline yourself**
 - Wear seatbelts
 - 5x more likely survive crash
 - 30x more likely to be ejected
 - Avoid distractions
 - Radio/Eating/Cell Phones
 - Texting
 - Avg 5 sec to check text
 - Travel football field @ 55 mph
- **Speed kills**
 - 2 sec rule good weather
 - 4 sec rule bad weather
- **Don't drink & drive**
 - Get a DD
 - Driving under the influence
 - BAC .05 - .08 = DL suspension 3-6 months/
fine 500-2000 euro
 - BAC .08 - .15 = DL suspension 6-12 months/
fine 800-3200 euro
 - BAC >.15 = DL 1-2yr susp/
fine 1.5-6k euro/veh confisc
- **Have a plan**
 - TRIPS - risk assessment

Winter Driving – be prepared

- Prepare Emergency Equipment
 - Spare tire, jack, tire tool
 - Reflective Vest
 - Triangle
 - First-aid kit
 - Flashlight
- Optional equipment
 - Jumper cables
 - Blanket/warm cloths/rain
 - Lighter/matches
 - Food/water
 - Small shovel/sand
- Prepare automobile
 - Inspection
 - Brakes
 - Oil
 - Radiator
 - Battery
 - Lights
 - Exhaust system
 - Heater/defroster
 - Wiper blades
 - Wiper fluid
 - Tires - M&S/Snow chains



Winter Driving Tires/Snow chains

• Winter Tires

- Nov. 15 – Apr. 15 (Italy)
- Nov. 1 – Apr. 15 (Austria)
- October - Easter (Germany)
- Penalty: 60-300 euro
- M+S, MS, M+S, M-S or



• Snow Chains

- UNI 11313 certification
- ONORM V5117 (Austrian)
