

Why Fire Prevention Saves Lives

Number 1 cause of fires in the US and in the Army – Home Cooking Fires – 156,600

The next largest cause is Home Heating Fires – 60,420 fires

Of great concern, the next largest contributor to home fires is Child related fires – 44,500 fires

Smoke alarms provide an early warning of a fire, giving people additional escape time. In 2009-2013, smoke alarms sounded in more than half (53%) of the home fires reported to U.S. fire departments. Three of every five home fire deaths resulted from fires in homes with no smoke alarms or no working smoke alarms (59%).

Fires in the U.S.

In 2015, there were 1,345,500 fires reported in the United States. These fires caused 3,280 civilian deaths, 15,700 civilian injuries, and \$14.3 billion in property damage.

- 501,500 were structure fires, causing 2,685 civilian deaths, 13,000 civilian injuries, and \$10.3 billion in property damage.
- 204,500 were vehicle fires, causing 500 civilian fire deaths, 1,875 civilian fire injuries, and \$1.8 billion in property damage.
- 639,500 were outside and other fires, causing 95 fire deaths, 825 fire injuries, and \$252 million in property damage.

Timeline of fires in the US

- One home structure fire was reported every 86 seconds.
- One civilian fire injury was reported every 34 minutes.
- One civilian fire death occurred every 2 hours and 40 minutes.
- One outside and other fire was reported every 52 seconds.
- One highway vehicle fire was reported every 3 minutes 1 seconds.





DES: Halloween – Parking and Access Control

- Trick or Treating Hours 1730-1930 on 29 October 2016
- Event parking begins at 1700. Plan additional time into your visit. Next door to Villaggio there will be a Circus in town with a show on the evening of our event.
- Parking from 1700-1930, Residents and Visitors, will be in School and CDC parking lot
- No vehicle traffic on Villaggio during Trick or Treating hours, exceptions are in the designated parking lots.
- Visitor Sponsoring
 - US ID Card Holders
 - Sign in two (2) adult parents and their children, 13 years and younger
 - All LN ID Card Holders
 - Must pre-register self and guests regardless of card holder/employee status
 - LN ID Card Holders may only sponsor their immediate family members (spouse and children 13 years of age and under)



DES: Halloween – Parking and Access Control (Cont)

- (Villaggio Main Gate) Registered guests of DOD ID Card Holders and LN Installation Pass Access must be requested NLT 20OCT16 for access through the Main Gate. Please fill out AE Form 190-16F (Access Roster). Email form immediately to usarmy.usag-Italy.usag.list.usag-vicenza-des-iacs@mail.mil with a subject line of Trick-or-Treat 2016 or drop off the form at the Installation Pass and Badge office in Building 4A. For more information, please call DSN 314-634-7053.
- Those who submitted their AE Form 190-16Fs can pick up their Temporary Trick or Treat passes beginning on 27 OCT 16 at Pass and Badge in Building 4A.
- Access Roster will be maintained at Villaggio Main Gate on day of event.
- Prohibited Items by Visitors. Bikes, Scooter, Skateboards, Hover Boards, Pets, Coolers, Bottles, Glass Containers, etc. The only exception is for infant care. i.e strollers.
