ANTITERRORISM TRAVEL INFORMATION

• Traveling outside of Italy for official or leave travel? Consult your unit Antiterrorism Officer (ATO) prior to travel to ensure you comply with foreign travel requirements for Active Duty, U.S. Government Employees, Contractors, and Local Nationals (LN's when on official travel only). Most countries have special reporting requirements for U.S. Government personnel which if not met, could result in expulsion or detention upon arrival. USAG Italy has published OPORD 16-045 (accessible on AKO at the following link with a CAC: <https://www.us.army.mil/suite/files/46273761>) to assist Commands in establishing compliant Foreign Travel Programs and the USAG Italy Garrison AT Office is available to conduct in depth training with Unit ATOs and other personnel assigned to coordinate overseas travel.
