The credit report may list Defense Manpower Data CE and/or DoD CE as the requester.

- Know what your critical information is:
 - Unclassified does NOT mean unimportant
 - Critical information is information our adversaries collect and need to do us harm
 - It includes, but is not limited to: user names and passwords, specifics on future operations, personally identifiable information, and military plans
 - What may be seemingly harmless information today may be critical in the future
 - Critical information can be combined with other critical information
 - Critical information changes as the mission changes
 - Every member should know their Command's critical information
 - Protection of critical information will help protect yourself, your fellow Soldiers, and your family

**POLITICAL ACTIVITIES INFORMATION**

- The 2016 election season is upon us with the U.S. general election scheduled for 8 November 2016. As always, to reinforce the confidence that the Nation has in the Army and its leaders, we must maintain the highest standards of public service and avoid even a minor perception of impropriety. I am, therefore, issuing this memorandum to reinforce the Army's existing policies with respect to transition and political activities. Addressees should ensure that their subordinates comply with law and policy governing political activities, including guidance in this memorandum.

Until further notice, Department of the Army personnel are prohibited from engaging with potential presidential candidates and their authorized representatives on any matter related to their official duties under any circumstances. Department of Army personnel shall report any contact from potential presidential candidates and their campaigns immediately to the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army, who is Army's Transition Assistance Coordinator.

ANTITERRORISM AWARENESS MONTH

- August is Antiterrorism Awareness Month for the U.S. Army, and U.S. Army Europe is hoping to raise awareness of the terrorist threat. Terrorism is an enduring, persistent, and worldwide threat to our nation and our armed forces in all locations and operating environments. Personnel must understand the threat, detect and deter terrorist activities, warn and defend against the full range of terrorist tactics. Antiterrorism is the defensive element in our fight against terrorists. It is very important for all USAG Italy Soldiers, DA Civilians, Local Nationals, Contractors, and Family Members to understand the terrorist threat to the community and the Army, and antiterrorism concepts and principles (e.g., the Force Protection Condition (FPCON) system), as they apply to themselves as individuals or members of the community. This understanding includes knowing what constitutes suspicious activity, what should be reported, and how to report those suspicious activities to law enforcement and/or security agencies.
