- On 15 September 2016, the Del Din shuttle bus will add one morning and one evening stop to Villaggio stop #4 each weekday and non-Federal Holiday. - Your POL coupons expire each year on 30 September, which affects your coupon purchases during the months of September and October.
  - Price of refund will be price of purchase. If the price cannot be determined, the lowest purchase point of sale will be used.
  - Coupons must be in fair condition -serial numbers and denominations must be legible.
  - Exception: Customers deployed during refund period. Orders must be presented in order to receive refund.
  - 2015-2016 POL coupons are valid through 30 September 2016 and will be refunded starting in September with dates to be determined by Tax Free Products Administrator. Maximum refund is for two month's allotment.
  - 2016-2017 POL coupons will be sold starting late September with the sale date determined by the Tax Free Products Administrator. These coupons can be used from 01 October 2016 and will be charged against your October 2016 – 2017 rations.

- ALARACT 078/2016, 2016 THREAT WARNING TO U.S. ARMY INSTALLATIONS AND STANDALONE FACILITIES FOR PUBLIC EVENTS AND VENUES ON THE 15TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE 9/11 ATTACKS (FOUO), DTG: R 011945Z SEP 16. This message is intended to warn U.S. Army commands, installations and facilities of the potential threat posed by extremists, particularly homegrown violent extremist and lone offenders, to public events and venues in the homeland. 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### INSTALLATION SECURITY OFFICE

- How is the SECURITY DETERMINATION MADE?
  - When a DoD military, civilian, or contractor's investigation is complete, it is sent to the DoD Consolidated Adjudications Facility (CAF). An adjudicator at the DoD CAF will review all of the information, both "good" and "bad" (remember, the "whole person") and assess the information against the National Security Adjudicative Guidelines.
  - If there is no information that raises a security concern, the individual will usually be granted a favorable security clearance eligibility at the level requested by their agency.
  - If there is information that raises a security concern, the adjudicator will evaluate the adverse information and mitigating factors per the National Security Adjudicative Guidelines when making the eligibility determination.
  - If significant adverse material is identified, the case may be delayed until additional information is gathered and facts are verified. Ultimately, an unfavorable security clearance eligibility determination may be made if the adverse information cannot be mitigated. 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### SUICIDE AWARENESS MONTH EVENTS

- On 12 SEP 16 from 0800-1200, Ask, Care, Escort - Suicide Intervention (ACE-SI) training will be held at Bldg. 305 on Ederle. ACE-SI is IAW Para 4-5.d., DA Pam 600-24 and Para 4-5.e., AR 600-guidance: Companies are required to provide Suicide Prevention training and to maintain trained personnel to provide Suicide Intervention at the Company level. ACE-SI is a one-time, 4-hour training module created to train the skills required to intervene in a suicide situation, and to provide annual ACE Suicide Prevention training at the Company level. Soldiers must have 1-year retainability. Training capacity is limited to 30 persons. Please report in Civilian attire.
- On 13 SEP 16 from 0800-1000 hours, there will be a Terrain Walk to present suicide awareness/prevention community resources. The Terrain Walk will begin at the Track Field on Ederle. Leaders, to include company level commanders and senior noncommissioned officers and above and civilian leaders, will participate in the Terrain Walk to familiarize themselves with Ready and Resilience support activities available within the community. Participants will physically visit and personally engage support activity specialists within the community.
- On 14 SEP 16 from 0900-1100 hours, the movie, "The Bridge" will be shown at the Post Theater on Ederle. The movie is a documentation of suicides and many near fatal moments. It is accompanied by interviews with families, friends, witness and several surviving attempters. Participants who attend will be given credit for Suicide Prevention Training for FY16.
