- The United States Army Health Center-Vicenza has kicked off its annual Army Flu Campaign. Influenza vaccination is mandatory for uniformed personnel and health care personnel who provide direct patient care and recommended for all others. In the United States, influenza results in more than 40 million reported cases, over 750,000 hospitalizations due to serious complications, and up to 50,000 deaths annually. - USAG ITALY OPERATION ORDER 17-013: Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony. - USAG ITALY TASKING 17-010: Designation of Restricted Areas within the USAG Italy Area of Responsibility. Background: IAW AR 190-13, The Army Physical Security Program, 25 February 2011, tenant units must nominate restricted areas to the Garrison Commander, USAG Italy who will subsequently review and approve each area.

- USAG ITALY TASKING 17-011: Master Resiliency Training (MRT) Roster for 30NOV-29DEC16. Background: With the release of the updated AER 612-1 (DTD 14 MAR 14), Garrison Commanders will establish an In-processing Training Center (ITC) that will in-process and prepare Soldiers for full-time duty. All Soldiers (except Soldiers on COTs and ITTs) must attend the community briefings/trainings. USAREUR units in each garrison AOR will provide MRTs on a rotational basis for the mandatory 16-hour Comprehensive Soldier and Family Fitness (CSF2) training.

- MILPER MESSAGE 16-314, PROCEDURAL GUIDANCE FOR UPLOADING SPECIFIC ARMY BODY COMPOSITION (ABC) DOCUMENTS IN THE PERSONNEL ELECTRONIC RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (IPERMS), ISSUED: [11/2/2016 7:50:42 AM]. This message issues guidance requiring the filing of specific documents into iPERMS for Soldiers that have been released from the Army Body Composition Program (ABCP). This message applies to all Army components. Effective 4 Aug 16, filing of specific documents from the ABCP packet (AR 600-9) is required in iPERMS per AR 600-8-104, appendix B. - MILPER MESSAGE 16-315, FISCAL YEAR 2017 (FY17) ACTIVE COMPONENT (AC), MAJOR (MAJ) CHAPLAINS CORPS, PROMOTION SELECTION BOARD (PSB) ZONES OF CONSIDERATION, ISSUED: [11/2/2016 2:23:46 PM]. PROTESTS

- "Vicenza Stands Up" (Vicenza Si Solleva/VSS) activists will stage an anti-war/anti-US presence protest on American Election Day (8 November 2016). They are calling the protest a "Peoples Walk" (Passeggiata Popolare), to begin at the former location of the No Dal Molin Presidio at the Merchese Bridge, at 2030 hours on 8 November 2016, and continue around the fence surrounding US Army Base Del Din, also known as Dal Molin. Italian Law Enforcement (ILE) considers this to be a significant, high profile protest because it commemorates the 10th anniversary of the people's opposition to the construction of US Base Del Din. Around 80 to 100 activists are expected to participate in the protest.

All members of the Vicenza Military Community should avoid the area of the protest to the maximum extent possible.

DPW ROAD CONSTRUCTION

- Currently, DPW will conducting road construction in front of Bldg. 307 (in front of the High School) to the Post Library. During this time roads will be open but parking will be limited.

INSTALLATION SECURITY OFFICE

- DID YOU KNOW - The Merit Systems Protection Board is an independent, quasi-judicial agency incorporated within the Executive Branch. The Board was established by the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978 (CSRA). The MSPB ensures that federal civil servants are hired and retained based on merit. In overseeing the personnel practices of the federal government, the Board conducts special studies of the merit systems; hears and decides charges of wrongdoing and employment appeals of adverse agency actions; and orders corrective disciplinary actions against an executive agency or employee when appropriate. The Board's independent special counsel investigates, among other things, prohibited personnel practices and allegations of activities proscribed by civil service laws, rules, and regulations, and prosecutes officials who violate civil service rules and regulations.
